

8th Annual PCSO Fallen Officers Memorial Charity Golf Tournament

Elmwood Golf Course Pueblo, Colorado, Saturday, July 9th, 2022



Golf Tournament Registration and Start:

Practice range ball will be available at the driving range prior to the start of tournament play. Range balls are provided courtesy of S.A.F.E. and there is no charge for tournament players.

Cash check or bank/credit card will be accepted for payment of tournament registration, mulligans, and raffle tickets. A beverage cart will be available on the course.

7:00 AM tournament registration will begin. \$100.00 per person or \$400.00 per team. Registration deadline is July 1st, 2022. A team captain must be designated at registration with a contact phone number.

Available for purchase are mulligans at \$5 each, limit of three per player, and tickets for a raffle will be sold for \$1 each, with no limit. Tickets for the raffle will be drawn during golf play and the prizes distributed at the conclusion of play.

Players will proceed to their assigned hole and await the start of play.

8:00 AM golfers will be alerted to begin play directed by golf pro.

All local rules will govern tournament play.

Food and Beverage:

Lunch will be available at 12:30 p.m. Players may claim their meal following play in the clubhouse. Your name will be provided to the restaurant staff for verification.

Beverages can be purchased either inside the clubhouse or the beverage cart on the course.

Tournament Play:

4 Player Scramble Format: All teammates will hit a drive, then hit their second and following shots from the position of best ball choice. Ball placement for second and additional shots must not be further than 1 club length from position of ball of choice without gaining any advantage. All teammates will putt from the position of the best ball.

All male golfers will use the white tee boxes while the women will use the red tee boxes.

Each golfer will use their drive at least once during the tournament.

A two-minute time limit will be requested on finding lost golf balls on the course.

All Tournament Play will end by 12:30 p.m. Please remember, we are on a time frame to allow for other golfers or another tournament to start play as well.

Sportsmanship and Integrity are very important to us. With that being said, let's go out and have a great time!

Prizes:

The tournament will be divided into 3 flights consisting of 7-8 teams per flight (Flight positions will be determined by score). Elmwood golf pro will tally up the scores at the end of the tournament and post the scores and team standings on a board. Tournament organizers will photograph the board, results will be posted on the S.A.F.E website at the conclusion of the tournament.

Monetary prizes for 1st and 2nd place finishers in each flight will be sent to the team captains for distribution to their team members.

Winner 1st Flight - \$100.00 per player 2nd Place finisher 1st Flight - \$50.00 per player

Winner 2nd Flight - \$50.00 per player 2nd Place finisher 2nd Flight - \$25.00 per player

Winner 3rd Flight - \$50.00 per player 3rd Place finisher 3rd Flight - \$25.00 per player

Non-monetary prizes will be awarded to the male and female longest drive and closest to the pin contests. You may claim your prize following the tournament

Longest drive hole for men will be hole #9 and for women will be hole #15.

Closes to the pin for men will be hole #7 and for women will be hole #4.

You may claim your prize at the clubhouse following play.

Tournament Conclusion:

Upon completing your round, team captains please turn in your scorecards to the head professional as soon as possible. Players, you may collect your lunch and non-monetary prizes at the clubhouse.

Winners of prizes will be drawn during play and can be collected at the end of the tournament play.
